V	The Old Covenant / Others' Ministry	The New Covenant / Paul's Ministry
1	Letters of recommendation (to or from) you.	
2		You are our letter of rec.; written on our hearts (not paper); read by everyone.
3	Written with ink; On stone tablets	You are a letter from Christ; ministry results; written with the Spirit; On human hearts
4		Confidence through Christ before God
5	Competence from self	Competence from God
6	The letter – it kills.	Ministers of a new covenant – of the Spirit; Gives life
7	Ministry of death; letters engraved on stone; glorious; could not look at it; fading glory	
8		Ministry of the Spirit; More glorious
9	Ministry that condemns men; Glorious	More glorious; Brings righteousness
10	Was glorious; Now no glory in comparison	Surpassing glory
11	Glory that was fading away.	Glory that lasts.
12		Therefore, hope; leading to boldness
13	Moses used a veil to cover fading glory	We are not like Moses.
14	Minds dull; old covenant (glory) is still veiled; Veil has not been removed.	Only in Christ is (the veil) taken away.
15	Even today a veil obscures the reading of Moses. Hearts are veiled.	
16		Turning to Christ removes the veil.
17		Lord is the Spirit; Where Spirit is there is freedom
18		Unveiled faces; reflect God's glory; we are being transformed to Christ's likeness; ever-increasing glory; from the Lord (Spirit).
