## JAMES 4

## James 4.1-12: Wars in the World

- 1. War with Each Other (4.1a, 11-12).
  - a. Class wars (2.1-9): Rich and poor.
  - b. Employment wars: (5.1-6): owners and labors.
  - c. Church fights (1.19-20; 3.13-18).
  - d. Personal (4.11-12).
- 2. War with Ourselves (4.1b 3): SELF
- 3. War with God (4.4-10): Enemies we are not to fraternize with:
  - a. World (4.4): Society and culture.
  - b. Flesh (4.1, 5) Old, sinful nature.
  - c. Devil (4.6-7): He wants us to depend on self and not God.
- 4. Peace not War.
  - a. Submit to God (4.7).
  - b. Draw near to God (4.8).
  - c. Humble yourself before God (4. 9-10).

## James 4.13-17: Pray and Plan

- a. Planning Scriptures
  - a. Matthew 6.34: "Do not be anxious about tomorrow".
  - b. Proverbs 16.9: "The heart of the man plans his way but the Lord establishes his steps".
- b. Plan Ahead
  - a. Three attitudes toward the Will of God
    - i. Ignoring God's Will (4.13-14, 16) Four arguments that reveals the foolishness of ignoring:
      - 1. Complexity of life (4. 13) Apart from the will of God, life is a mystery
      - 2. Uncertainty of life (4.14a) See Luke 12.16 about the rich, foolish farmer.
      - 3. Brevity of life (4.14b) See Job. We don't want to "spend our lives", "waste our lives, but "invest our lives" in those things eternal.
      - 4. Frailty of man (4. 16) "you boast and brag".
    - ii. Disobeying God's Will (4.17) You know God's will but disobey. Why?
      - 1. Pride.
      - 2. Ignorance of the nature of God's will thinking you can accept or reject it.

iii. Obeying God's Will (4.15) "If the Lord will" is not a statement but the constant attitude of the heart.

## b. God's Will

- 1. Know His Will (Acts22.14) We need to be "filled with the knowledge of His will and all wisdom and spiritual understanding" (Col 1.9).
- 2. Understand His will (Eph 5.17).
- 3. Prove His Will (Rom 12.2) Prove is to prove by experience (Greek translation).
- c. Benefits of Doing His Will.
  - 1. Deeper fellowship with Jesus Christ (Mk 3.35).
  - 2. Knowing God's truth (Jn 7.17).
  - 3. Seeing your prayers answered (1 Jn 5.14-15).
  - 4. Eternal quality to life (1 Jn 2.15-17).
  - 5. Expectation of reward upon Christ's return (Matt 25.34).
